



5.50 Heads-Up Index Class Rules

This class has been developed to accommodate the serious LS enthusiast that may not have a class specific build. The performances we will see in this class will be exciting to watch and compete. The class will be full of entries at different power levels but everyone will still have the same ET limit to adjust to. The entry must be LS or LT powered and be able to pass NHRA tech for ET and Speed. For any pair of entries that exceed 5.50 et during eliminations, the closest to 5.50 will be declared the winner as long as both entries left the starting line with green lights. Any run in qualifying that exceeds 5.50 seconds will be placed on the bottom of the ladder. Lane choice will be determined by gentleman's agreement or coin flips for all elimination rounds.

- All Run Field, 1/8th mile, .400 Pro Tree, Auto Start will be in effect
- Qualify against 5.50 Index, Pro Ladder
- 5.50 break-out rule
- Bye runs – all vehicles must take the tree
- Must be LS or LT powered
- Any power adder
- Trans brake allowed
- All chassis combinations permitted
- Electric shifter & air shifter OK
- No tire restrictions
- Nitrous button or micro switch OK
- Tech officials have final discretion on all rules on race day
- All NHRA Safety Rules Apply
